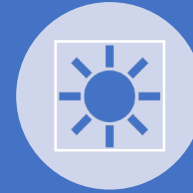
- Covid 19 and the pandemic has changed the landscape of the last 2 years.

Students have missed a lot of face-to-face teaching over the past 2 years

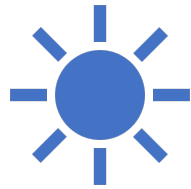


It has been difficult to cover all the topics that would normally be completed in 2 years of study

These topics will be made available to teachers before 7th February 2022
