

Key stage 3

What is being taught?

Year 7 learners start to review what it means to live in the wider world. What affects us in our lives that we cannot control to how our actions verbally and physically will impact upon another person life and the consequences to these actions.

Year 8 will be given the opportunity to understand the educational pathways that are open them. Develop their knowledge in where education can take them. What is needed to be successful in different fields of work and how they can work towards their dream job.

Year 9 will start a new unit to allow them to investigate personal planning. This unit investigates the tools needed to develop a personal plan to achieve their current goals.

How is it being taught?

Year 7 will be taught to understand how to live in the wider world. Practical work on where money is spent as an adult and considerations that have to be made. To reviewing people actions and the consequences through case studies and class discussion the impact what we can do in society.

Year 8 will be using case studies personal experiences and discussion to develop their knowledge of the benefits of physical health. Experience physical lesson to help improve their understanding and the benefits of having an active lifestyle.

Year 9 will use research methods, class discussion to build up a toolbox of techniques to help them with personal planning. There will be the opportunity to speak to have guest speakers in to talk about how to be organised and why planning is essential to them achieving in their life goals. From the knowledge they gain through the lesson they complete a booklet showing their thoughts and understanding and working towards a qualification.

Key stage 4

What is being taught?

The vocational learner will be building upon their knowledge gained through y9 but then delving deeper in all the aspects covered. They will develop and review more complex personal planning techniques that will help them later in life and into adulthood.

How is it being taught?

The vocational pathway will use practical and theory lessons to help them try different techniques to develop their own personal planning techniques that work for them through practical work. This knowledge they will then use to complete a booklet towards their potential qualification.
