On 17th October. Year 11 students will be developing their skills through a mock interview with myself and our External Enterprise Adviser. We will be working through interview technique and trying to help these students feel more comfortable with completing this part of the transition process.

Students have been working on writing an application letter and developing their CV in English sessions so that they can then use these during their mock interviews.

We will also be viewing an interview presentation from our apprenticeship advisor to help them hone their skills. This is available to all Key stage 4 students.

Later in the week we will also be looking at writing a CV. Again, our apprenticeship advisor will be presenting the afternoon to all key stage 4 students.
