## Destinations of Year 11 Students

Educated in Cambridgeshire (**not** including Independent Schools)

This booklet gives detailed figures about the destinations of students in Cambridgeshire who had reached statutory school leaving age by 31st August 2022.

**Please note** that these tables relate to the activities and status of young people at 1st November 2022, rather than to their first destination after leaving statutory education. This is the date we are asked to use by the Department for Education and is considered to be a more reliable indicator of sustained participation. Percentages may not always add up to 100, due to rounding of figures.

Some of the tables in this pack are a result of very detailed analysis. If you are unsure of the derivation of any information, or its meaning, please contact Mark Cowdell.

## Year 11 destinations – 2022 and 2021 compared (please see table 2 for previous years comparison)

### The figures for all students show:

- the overall numbers in the year 11 cohort is slightly smaller than last year (6213 compared to 6246)
- there has been a decrease in the percentage of young people moving into full time education, now 91.58% (92.33% in 2021)
- a slight decrease in the percentage of young people in learning, now 95.51% (95.92% in 2021)
- an increase in the percentage of young people who are NEET (not in education, employment or training) now 2.29% (1.92% in 2021)
- an increase in the percentage of young people going into employment with training, now 3.40% (2.85% in 2021)
- a slight increase in the percentage of young people going into employment without any accredited training, now 1.61% (1.59% in 2021)

### The figures for students from Mainstream Schools only show:

- the percentage of students moving into full time education has decreased to 93.82% (94.34% in 2021)
- an increase in percentage of young people going into employment with training, now 3.31% (2.86% in 2021)
- a slight increase in percentage of young people going into employment without any accredited training, now 0.87% (0.83% in 2021)
- the percentage of young people NEET has slightly increased, now 1.19% (1.04% in 2021)

We have again split down reports for students in special schools, those attending alternative provision, those electively home educated and also a table for all students eligible for pupil premium.

### The figures for students from Special Schools, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has decreased from last year to 87.88% (93.13% in 2021)
- % of young people in learning has decreased to 93.94% (95.6% in 2021)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has decreased to 0.0% (0.63% in 2021)
- % of young people who are NEET has increased to 6.06% (3.13% in 2021)

### The figures for students from Elective Home Education, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has increased slightly to 68.56% (62.37% in 2021)
- % of young people in learning has increased slightly to 73.2% (72.0% in 2021)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has increased to 15.98% (12.37% in 2021)
- % of young people who are NEET has decreased to 7.73% (11.83% in 2021)

### The figures for students from Alternative education provision, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has significantly decreased to 59.41% (66.82% in 2021)
- % of young people in learning has also decreased to 68.62% (71.6% in 2021)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has decreased to 8.37% (13.27% in 2021)
- % of young people who are NEET has significantly increased to 21.76% (14.22% in 2021)

### The figures for students eligible for Pupil Premium, show:

- % of students moving into full time education has decreased to 87.14% (89.29% in 2021)
- % of young people in learning has decreased to 91.24% (93.5% in 2021)
- % of young people who are in employment without training has slightly increased to 2.38% (2.02% in 2021)
- % of young people who are NEET has increased to 5.73% (3.95% in 2021)
